

CLUBHOUSE AND FACILITIES DRESS GUIDELINES 2018

General Guideline – Exmoor prides itself on being one of the finest clubs in the country. Our members, their families, and their guests should always dress in a manner and style that reflects this pride.

Unacceptable Dress:

- Men's caps, hats or visors are <u>not</u> permitted to be worn in <u>any</u> area of the Clubhouse other than the Men's Locker Room. Where hats are allowed (e.g. golf course, tennis/paddle courts, pool complex, curling facility, golf practice facilities) they must <u>always</u> be worn in the forward position only
- Tee-shirts or clothing that exposes the midriff, except at the pool complex
- Cargo shorts or short shorts
- Any clothing that is cut, cut-off, torn or with holes, including denim
- Athletic apparel except at the Oakhouse while engaged with paddle, curling or other athletic activities
- Clothing with excessive, large or inappropriate logos or graphics

Acceptable Dress:

Club Casual Attire: The Grill, Trophy Bar, Founders Room, Wine Room, Ross Room, Dining Terraces and Clubhouse second floor private event space

- Men's attire includes collared shirts, banded collared dress shirts or turtle neck shirts with dress trousers. Dress shorts are permitted in season
- Corresponding appropriate attire is expected for women. Skirts and dresses should be an appropriate and conservative length. White denim may be worn in a style fitting a private country club standard, in good taste and neatness with no holes or distressed/tattered appearance
- Children age ten or older are required to comply with the adult dress code. Younger children should dress in good taste

Winter Casual Attire: The Oakhouse from mid-September to mid-May

- Men's attire includes collared shirts, banded collared dress shirts or turtle neck shirts with dress trousers or slacks. Denim trousers may be worn in a style fitting a private country club standard, in good taste and neatness with no holes or distressed/tattered appearance
- Corresponding appropriate attire is expected for women. Skirts and dresses should be an appropriate and conservative length

• Children age ten or older are required to comply with the adult dress code. Younger children should dress in good taste

Club-based Sports Attire:

- Golf attire is acceptable for lunch in all areas of the Club
- Tennis attire is acceptable on the Dining Terraces and the Ross Room during tennis season
- Curling and Paddle attire is acceptable only in the winter months (usually mid-September through mid-May) in the Ross Room, Dining Terraces, Men's Locker Room Bar and Oakhouse
- Golf Attire (on the golf course or any golf practice areas)
 - Men: Slacks or Bermuda-length shorts with a collared shirt. Shirts must be tucked in at all times
 - Women: Slacks, golf skirts, shorts, shirts with collars and jewel neck shirts. Women may wear sleeveless shirts if they are designed specifically for golf. A woman's top designed to be worn on the outside of an outfit is acceptable, provided that the garment is hemmed and does not expose the midriff
 - Juniors: All attire regulations apply to junior golfers
 - All denim, including white denim, is prohibited from all golf areas
- Tennis Attire
 - Men: Tennis shorts, tennis shirts with collars or without collars if they are specifically made for tennis. Warm-up type attire is acceptable
 - Women: Tennis shorts, tennis skirts, tennis shirts with collars; or without collars if they are specifically made for tennis. Women may wear sleeveless shirts if they are designed specifically for tennis. Warm-up type attire is acceptable
 - Juniors: All attire regulations apply to junior tennis players
 - All denim, including white denim, is prohibited from the tennis courts
- Paddle Tennis Attire
 - Athletic attire including athletic shorts, athletic shirts, workout clothing, warm-up attire and tennis or other non-marking athletic shoes
- Curling Attire
 - Casual and athletic attire including workout clothing and warm-up attire. Curling shoes or clean-soled, non-slip shoes must be worn on the ice
- Swimming Pool Attire
 - Swim attire is restricted to the pool area, parking lot, locker rooms and to and from the parking lot and pool area. Denim, other than white denim on the pool deck, is prohibited
